

Oldfashioned christmas cones



Yarn: Scheepjes maxi sweet treat. In the yarn-kit from favoritgarner there are material to make 3 different colour combinations; 1green (412) with a white (105) edge, 1blue grey (393) with a golden (179) edge, 1 red (115) with a green (412) edge.

You also need some wood glue

Crochet hook 1,5 mm

US-terms used

sc single crochet

ch chain

dc double crochet


sl st slip stitch

Picot ch 3, 1sc in the first ch




1. Ch 3, make a sl st to form a ring. Ch 3 (=first dc) and 11 dc around the ring, sl st in the third ch, =12dc.

2. Ch 4 (=1dc+ch 1), *1dc, ch 1* repeat ** 10 more times. Sl st in the third ch. Now you have 12dc with one chain between each.

- **3.** Sl st to the space between the dc:s, ch 3, 2dc in the space, *3dc in the next space* Repeat ** til you finished the row. Sl st in the third cg.=36dc.
- **4.** Ch 2, 2dc together (= first 3 dc together), ch 4, *3dc together, ch 4* Repeat ** 10 more times, sl st in the top of the firs 3 dc together.

5. Ch 3, 1dc in the tip, ch 2, 2dc in the tip, 1sc in the ch space,* (2dc, ch 2, 2dc) in the next tip, 1sc in the ch space* Repeat **10 more times, sl st in the third ch.

6. 2sl st to the first ch space. (ch 3, 1dc, ch 2, 2dc) in the same ch space, ch 3, *(2dc, ch 2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch 3* Repeat **10 more times, sl st in the third ch.

7. 2 sl st to the first ch space (ch 3, 1dc, ch 2, 2dc) in the ch space, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in the ch 3-space, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch2, 1sc in the ch 3-space, ch2, *(2dc, ch2, 2dc) in



the next ch space, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in the ch 3-space, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch 2, 1sc in the ch 3-space, ch2* Repeat ** 4 more times, make a sl st in the third ch.

8. 2sl st to the first ch space, (ch 3, 1dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch 1, (2dc, ch 2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch 1 (2dc, ch 2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch 4, *(2dc, ch2, 2dc, ch 1)x3, ch 3* Repeat ** 4 more times, end with a sl st.



9. 2 sl st to the first ch space, (ch 3, 1dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch 1, 9dc in the next ch space, ch1, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch 2, 1sc in the next ch space, ch2, * (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch1, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the next ch space, ch2, 1sc in the next ch space, ch2, 1sc in the next ch space, ch2* Repeat ** 4 more times, end with a sl st.

10. 2 sl st to the first ch space, (ch3, 1dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc, ch1)x9, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch5, *(2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc, ch1)x9, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch5.* Repeat ** 4 more times, end with a sl st.





11. 2 sl st to the first ch space, (ch3, 1dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc in the space between the dc:s, ch1)x8, (2dc, ch2, 2dc), ch1, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in the ch 5-space, ch1, *(2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc in the space between the dc:s, ch1)x8, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in the ch 5-space, ch1* Repeat ** 4 more times, end with a sl st.

12. 2 sl st to the first ch space, (ch3, 1dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc in the space between the dc:s, ch1)x7, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, *(2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (1dc in the space between the dc:s, ch1)x7, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the ch space, ch1* Repeat ** 4 more times, end with a sl st.

Cut the yarn and start with colour 2.



Edge:

Start in the same ch space as you has done earlier, in the ch space you make. *1sc, 1 picot, 1sc in the same ch space, 1sc in the next ch, 1 picot)x7, 1sc in the next ch, 1sc in the next ch space, 1picot, 1sc in the same ch space, 1sc in the next ch, 1picot, 1sc in the same ch, 1sc in the next ch space, 1picot, 1sc in the same ch space, 1sc in the next ch, 1picot, 1sc in the same ch* Repeat ** in the rest of the row.

Iron the doily.

Edge:






Tassel:

Wind the yarn 30 rows around your hand. Put a thread through the middle and make a knot.. Fold and make a knot around the tassel to keep it together. Cut evenly in the lower side.



Strengthening:

Put a piece of aluminium foil at your bench or table. Mix some wood glue and some water in a cup. Brush the gluemix on the doily, at both sides. Fold one side of the dolily and roll it together to a cone. Form it with your hands until you are satisfied. The cone will sink together in the beginning and you may have to form it a few times before it's totally dry. Sometimes I give them a hand with the hairdryer in the end, forming it at the same time.





Put the cone together

When the cone has dryed its time to put on the tassel and to make a loop to hang the cone in the christmastree.

- 1. Sew with a small needle trough the both sides in the lower side of the cone
- 2. Twist the threads a couple of rows around the tassel and make a knot at the bakside.
- 3. Fasten the thread at the back of the cone, ch 20 and sew it in the other side.
