

”Aquarel” pillow case

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Pattern for private use. If you want to use my pattern in other ways please contact me for permission:

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Yarn: 11 balls Scheepjes soft fun aquarel 50g, or you can use soft fun or soft fun denim. The three different yarns together makes nice colour effects and can be used in the same pillow.

Crochet hook: 4 mm

Other: Pillow 50x50 cm, if you want to be able to take of and wash the pillowcase you can use a zipper 40 cm.

Make 2 squares:

Read the diagram from the right bottom. The first hdc in each row is replaced with ch 2.

1. Ch 106, not to tight
2. Start crocheting in the fourth ch, 1 dc in each ch = 104 dc. This is the first row in the diagram.
3. Crochet **C** 1 time (=15 stitches), **B** 4 times (= 80 stitches), and last **A** 1 time (=9 stitches) = totally 104 stitches.
4. Continue following the diagram and repeat the 4 rows until you made the 4 rows totally 19 times, crochet one more row, cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Now it's time to join the two squares. Put the wrong sides together, with the right side up. Start in a corner. 3 sc in the corner, 1 sc in each stitch along the side, repeat 3 more times. If you want to be able to take off and wash the pillow case, leave a gap in the bottom of the pillow case, which fits the size of the zipper, and sew the zipper with a sewing machine.
